GUEST ARRIVAL EXPERIENCE

Upon arrival, please proceed to the check-in desk located at the lobby of the Yuxianghu Hotel (address: No.3333, Xianghu Road, Wenyan Street, Xiaoshan District, Hangzhou, Zhejiang), after 2 p.m. on Sunday, and the hotel front desk staff has your name on the room list. You will be issued a room key card, name tag, and other relevant information pertaining to your stay. All of our guests will be assigned a single occupancy room (with a king or queen bed). The checkout is before 12 p.m. on Friday, and guests' luggage can be stored at the hotel concierge on Friday.

MEETING ROOMS

All of the meetings/workshops will be held at the Lecture Hall on the second level, Block 8, Academic Island. We have around 50 chairs in the room. Masks are optional whilst indoors on campus grounds.

All the technology instructions for the workshop will be given on the morning of the first day of the conference.
